



1st Week of Advent: Jesus is Our Hope (Candle Color: Purple)

Hope: to trust in, wait for, look for, or desire something or someone; a secure assurance, a trust placed in a trustworthy God

Prayer: Lord Jesus, we believe you are the Messiah - God's promise and gift of salvation for the world. Thank you for coming to dwell among us and be the way for humanity to experience life with God again. We long for the day when your righteousness, justice and love reign and rule on this earth without the hinderance of evil. Jesus, you are our hope. Amen.

2nd Week of Advent: Jesus is Love (Candle Color: Purple)

Love: to be full of good will towards, to have a preference for, to regard the welfare of

4th Week of Advent: Jesus is Our Peace (Candle Color: Purple)
